EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

Students receive differentiated instruction daily through What I Need (WIN) time. Teachers and support staff use multiple forms of assessments and professional expertise to make sure that students receive the correct extra support they need. Teachers and staff are constantly collaborating to plan for the best academic schedule for each of our students.



AWARDS AND NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Hillsdale has received the Title 1 Distinguished School Award for three years because of our academic performance. Hillsdale students enjoy the visual and performing arts in many ways. Classroom teachers integrate the arts into their instruction. Schoolwide 'Sing' brings joy each week for our children. Art specialists come to every class weekly, with a music teacher teaching our intermediate grades and a visual art teacher teaching our primary children.



ACADEMICS AND ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Hillsdale is home to the RISE program (Reaching Independence through Structured Education), BRIDGE and TAP (Transitional Academic Program) for students with disabilities. Also, The Greater Sacramento Boys and Girls Club provides after school recreation, homework help and enrichment for Hillsdale children. These services are free to families and enhance our students with literacy, technology, sports and tutoring. Staff also provide after school tutoring as needed. Field trips and assemblies bring new learning experiences to our children. Family events encourage family learning for all.

Our Parent Teacher Association (PTA) works with staff on family events that bring us all together with a family craft night, game night and family dances.

Community partners also contribute to our school in many ways, such as classroom presentations, family science night, donations of backpacks, etc. We appreciate all of the involvement and encourage everyone to participate.
