## SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS

Regency Park Elementary promotes the inclusion of our students by focusing on meeting their academic, social and emotional needs. Each month, Regency Park focuses on a character trait that good citizens exemplify. Our student leadership team also focuses on good citizenship, organizing many opportunities to donate food and clothing to those less fortunate. Here at Regency, we fully embrace Project Based Learning, a teaching method in which students gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period of time to investigate and respond to authentic, engaging and complex questions, problems, or challenges. As a culminating activity, each grade level provides an evening presentation for their families. The staff at Regency Park understands the need for fun! The Regency Park community participates in Spirit Days, Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) events, and many other fun events put on by our Parent Teacher Association (PTA), including movie and craft nights.

Regency Park Elementary aims to develop young adults that are college and career ready. Our academic programs are designed to accommodate all learners through both technology and group interventions including i-Ready, Imagine Learning, IXL Math, and Accelerated Reader (AR) programs.



## EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

Academically, our school is one of the top-performing schools in the Twin Rivers Unified School District (TRUSD). Regency Park Elementary boasts high CAASPP scores during the most recent SBAC testing, at 51% proficient or above in Language Arts and 41% proficient or above in math. A huge piece of this achievement is due to implementing Project Based Learning in all grade levels. Students have the opportunity to show what they have learned about the world around them through song, dance, research, drama and other hands-on activities.



## NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Regency Park Elementary earned a 2016 Gold Ribbon School Award from the California Department of Education. The Gold Ribbon Awards recognize California schools that have made gains in implementing the academic content and performance standards adopted by the State Board of Education. Our students participate in the annual TRUSD speech contest and have won first place in the past.

Working with TRUSD, we have implemented both a before and after school program to support students and their families.



## ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Regency Park Elementary offers a variety of enrichment opportunities outside of the regular school day including:

- After school classes for Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) students, Early Engineers and Firefly Art classes
- Food of the Month program available for students three days a week at our salad bar
- Regency Park Elementary participates in Walktober, Two Feet Tuesdays, and May Is Bike Month, where we have logged the most miles of any school in the Sacramento area nine times in the past twelve years
- K-2nd grade students participate in the TRUSD visual arts program
- 3rd-6th grade students participate in the TRUSD music program
- 4th graders participate in Link-Up, where they learn to play the recorder and then have an assembly with members of the Sacramento Philharmonic Symphony
- 6th graders have the opportunity to attend a 3 day/overnight environmental camp
- Students have the opportunity to participate in after school sports including soccer, basketball, cross country and cheerleading
