Dear AP Students & Parents/Guardians,

Taking Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Oswego High School recommends that all students take AP exams for the AP classes in which they are enrolled during the 2023-24 school year. Scoring well on an AP exam can earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. Advanced Placement exams will be administered at Oswego High School from May 6 to May 17, 2024. You can find the schedule for AP exams on the following page of this letter. The cost per AP exam is \$102. The cost for the AP Capstone exams (AP Seminar and AP Research) is \$150.00 each. Fee waivers will be provided for income qualified students.

Registration for AP exams through the College Board (Step 1) and Payment through Total Registration (Step 2) will be available from Monday, September 4, 2023 at 12:00 AM until Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM.

Registrations that have *not* been paid for in-full through Total Registration will be canceled and exams will *not* be ordered. Per College Board, any late registrations will incur a late fee of \$40.00 per exam. Thus, late registrations will cost \$142 per AP Exam; AP Capstone Exams (AP Seminar and AP Research) will cost \$190 per exam.

AP Exams can be canceled with no penalty until **Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM**. AP Exams canceled after this date will receive a partial refund, as the College Board charges a \$40 fee for unused exams. While the AP Exams are in the spring, AP Exam registration occurs in the fall. Please be sure to read the following information carefully regarding the registration and payment deadlines and fees.

Students must complete Step 1 AND Step 2 in order for AP Exams to be ordered:

Step 1: Register for AP Exams

- Registration for AP exams through the **College Board** will be available from Monday, September 4, 2023 at 12:00 AM until Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM.
- Log into myap.collegeboard.org.
- Click on “Register for Exam” for *each* class section in which you are enrolled. If you do not see AP courses in your account, you must see your AP teacher(s) for the join code.
- Select “Confirm Registration” if you are choosing to take the AP Exam, **OR** select “No, I wish to remove myself from taking this exam,” if you are choosing *not* to take the AP Exam.

Step 2: Pay for AP Exams

- Payment for AP exams in **Total Registration** will take place Monday, September 4, 2023 at 12:00 AM until Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM.
- Parents/Guardians and students login to <https://user.totalregistration.net/AP/143330>. We strongly recommend that parents *and* students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.
 - Registrations *not* paid in-full through Total Registration will be canceled and exams will *not* be ordered.
 - Any late registrations will cost \$142 per AP Exam. AP Capstone Exams (AP Seminar and AP Research) will cost \$190 per exam. This includes a \$40.00 late fee per exam.
