SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS

Kohler School, in close partnership with families and the community, is a school where all PK-8 children learn in a rigorous, engaging, safe, educational environment in preparation for college, career, and life success. Our dedicated staff works hard to ensure that every student reaches his or her learning targets as described by the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). At Kohler, we value, respect, and engage with the diverse cultures represented within our school, striving to create a family-friendly environment that fosters mutual respect, trust, and care.



EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

Students who attend Kohler Elementary School receive a comprehensive, coherent academic program with a strong emphasis on language arts and math. In language arts, we focus on early literacy, reading comprehension, academic vocabulary and writing across disciplines. Our math program focuses on problem-solving, mathematical fluency, and deep conceptual understanding using real-world problems.



NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Kohler Elementary boasts one of the highest attendance rates in the district and was on track to again improve SBAC scores for a 4th consecutive year. Kohler also decreased the number of students who were chronically absent during the 2019-2020 school year.



ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

We are proud to continue providing our K-6 students with exposure to visual and performing arts through weekly art and music lessons provided by staff members who hold or are pursuing an art teaching credential. Our 7th and 8th grade students participate in varied elective classes four days a week: Visual Arts, Performing Arts, Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) class, academic study hall, and Student Leadership. Kohler also fields a team in the local Lego Robotics Tournament each year. Students identified as Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) participate in project-based learning modules after school. This year our focus is on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) challenges.

Kohler School partners with the Eskaton senior living community to bring kindergarten and 3rd grade children together with “buddies” residing in Eskaton communities. Students and seniors connect by reading books, doing art projects, singing songs and much more. Kohler also partners with the YMCA to provide a free after school program for our students from dismissal until 6 p.m. every school day of the year. The YMCA staff provide homework assistance, arts and crafts, a character development program, and service-learning experience.
