Governance **A.** [Schedule Annual Organizational Meeting of the Board](#) Action
 Education Code §35143 requires that Organizational meetings in years in which a regular election for governing board members is conducted shall be conducted "within a 15-day period that commences with the second Friday in December following the regular election." The period for the 2024 Annual Organizational Meeting is December 13-27. It is recommended that this be scheduled during our Regular Board Meeting on Wednesday, December 18, 2024 at 6:00 pm at Center Joint Unified School District Board Room, 3243 Center Court Lane, Antelope, CA 95843 and/or virtual.

↓ **B.** [Professional Services Agreement between Woolpert Strategic Consulting and Atkinson, Andelson, Lloyd, Rudd and Romo, on behalf of Center Joint Unified School District, for Trustee Area Creation Services](#) Action
 Center Joint Unified School District currently uses an at-large system of electing the members of its Board of Education. Under state law an at-large method of election may be deemed to impair the ability of some voters to elect candidates of their choice or to influence the outcome of elections and, therefore, may be subject to challenge under the California Voting Rights Act of 2001, California Elections Code §§ 14025, et seq. Resolution #4/2024-25: Resolution Initiating Process of Establishing Trustee Areas and Elections by Trustee Area for District Governing Board Members was approved by the Board on October 16, 2024 to initiate the legal and regulatory process. Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Ruud and Romo has recommended that we use Woolpert Strategic Consulting for the Trustee Voting Area Creation Services. Attachment A: Scope of Services, included in the Professional Services agreement, lists the services that would be provided.

Personnel **C.** [Revised Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators, 2024-2025](#) Action
 The Department of Education and the Commission on Teacher Credentialing regulations for the issuance of emergency teaching credentials require individual districts to submit a "Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators" each year for any anticipated certificated positions that may need to be filled with an individual holding an emergency credential. In the event a District may wish to employ any teacher(s) needing emergency credentials, school districts are required to file a "Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators" at the beginning of each school year. The "Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators" is to be approved by the Board and will be valid for one school year. Each year, a new "Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators" must be filed at the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
